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Materials



- o Yarn: City Tweed DK (in 3 colors, shown in Snowshoe, Tabby, and Toad)
- o Hook: Furls H 5.00mm LE Masur Birch
- o Scissors
- o Yarn Needle
- o Measuring Tape
- o Optional: Furls Lucet Fork
- o Optional: Hemp cord, twine, or ribbon

Cozy days!

Whether it's just a normal day, a holiday, or a sick day, the Rustic Gingham Tissue Cover is cozy for any day of the year. Though designed for the Cozy Holiday Crochet Along, this rustic gingham cover is also great for cabins, gift giving to guys, or crochet accent to any room in the house!



INTERMEDIATE

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 15 sc = 4"
18 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Height	Circumference
One Size	8.5"	19"

Pattern Key

- Ch(s): Chain(s)
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- BLO: Back Loop Only
- Slst: Slip Stitch
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- Beg: Beginning
- *: Repeat according to instructions

Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain does not count as a stitch.

Base of pattern is worked back and forth in rows. Edging of base is worked in the round along with the remaining rounds in the pattern. Work over alternating yarn in that row. Third color in every other round can either be finished off or carried up the join on the wrong side.

Specialty Stitches:

Picot: Ch 5, slst into base stitch (sc in this pattern). Find a written and video tutorial [here](#).

Pattern Instructions

Ch 17 with color A

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st across - 16 sts

Rows 2-3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across - 16 sts

Rows 4-11: Ch 1, turn, hdc in each st across - 16 sts

Rows 12-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across - 16 sts

Round 15: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in same, sc in next 14, 2 sc in last, rotate to work down raw edge, work 2 sc in first row end, work 14 sc evenly down to last row end, 2 sc in last row end, rotate to work along beg chain, 2 sc in first ch, sc in next 14 chs, 2 sc in last ch, rotate to work up raw edge, work 2 sc in first row end, work 14 sc evenly up raw edge, 2 sc in last row edge, join - 72 sts

From here on out, work over color not being used

Round 16: Working in BLO for entire round, ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 17: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color B - 72 sts

Round 18: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color C, alternate color B and color C every 3 sc around, join with color B - 72 sts

Round 19: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color C, alternate color B and color C every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 20: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 21: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color B - 72 sts

Repeat Rounds 18-21 five additional times for a total of 41 rounds.

Round 42: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color C, alternate color B and color C every 3 sc around and working a picot in ever sixth stitch, join with color B - 72 sts, 12 picots

Work Round 43 by keeping picots in front of stitches

Round 43: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color C, alternate color B and color C every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 44: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 45: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color B - 72 sts

Round 46: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color C, alternate color B and color C every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Round 47: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2 switching to color B, alternate color A and color B every 3 sc around, join with color A - 72 sts

Repeat Rounds 44-47 once more. Finish off and weave in ends.

Tie:

Make a chain, i-cord (with Lucet Fork), or a row of single crochets roughly 19" in length. Hemp cord, twine, ribbon or other materials can also be used. Add length for a longer tie.

Finally, weave tie through picots making sure to have both ends count out on the right side.
