- Riverwalk Poncho by Crystalized Designs -

Materials



Yarn: Red Heart Soft (1175 yards for short version, 1615 yards for long version) *Extra yardage needed for fringe
Hook: L-8.00mm

- o Scissors
- o Yarn Needle

Poncho Style!

The Riverwalk Poncho is perfect year round! Wear it on cooler summer nights or all winter long, the season doesn't matter. This poncho can be paired with a cami or a long sleeve shirt, or worn vertically for another fun look!



INTERMEDIATE

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 11 dc = 4" 5 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

One Size	Varies	40"
Size	Length	Width

*Measurement when worn horizontally.

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Dc2tog: Double Crochet 2 Together
- Cl: Cluster (see page 3)
- YO: Yarn Over
- RS: Right Side
- WS: Wrong Side
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- *: Repeat instructions between symbol until indicated

Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain does not count as a stitch.

When stitch counts are listed, they will be listed in sequential order. Chains are not included in counts.

Short length = 18" in length

Long Length = 25" in length

Specialty Stitching:

Cluster (cl): YO, insert hook into indicated ch/st and pull up a loop, YO, insert hook into same ch/st and pull up a loop twice (7 loops on hook), YO and pull through all loops on hook

Pattern Instructions

Back Side of Poncho

Ch 122

- Row 1: (RS) Starting in 4th ch, work 3 dc2tog over 6 chs, ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 chs, *6 dc2tog over next 12 chs, ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 chs, repeat * to last 6 chs, 3 dc2tog over next 6 chs - 77 sts
- Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, turn, starting in same, sc in each st and ch across 119 sts
- Row 3: Ch 2, turn, starting in same, work 3 dc2tog over 6 sts, ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 sts, *6 dc2tog over next 12 sts, ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 sts, repeat * to last 6 sts, 3 dc2tog over next 6 sts - 77 sts
- Row 4: Ch 1, turn, starting in same, sc in each st and ch across 119 sts
- Repeat Row 3-4 fourteen more times for short, twenty more times for long. Finish off.

Front Side of Poncho

- With right side facing, join yarn in first chain (end with tail).
- Row 1: (RS) Ch 2, cl in same, ch 1, cl in next, ch 1, cl in next, ch 1, *6 dc2tog over next 12 chs, ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 chs, repeat * once more, 5 dc2tog over next 10 chs, ch 30, skip 26 chs, 5 dc2tog over next 10 chs, ch 1, **[cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 chs, 6 dc2tog over next 12 chs, ch 1, repeat ** once more, cl in next, ch 1, cl in last, ch 1, cl in same, ch 1 to close cl - 60 sts
- Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, turn, starting in ch 1 to close cl, sc in each st and ch across 120 sts
- Row 3: Ch 2, cl in same, ch 1, cl in next, ch 1, cl in next, ch 1, 6 dc2tog over next 12 sts, *ch 1, [cl, ch 1] 5 times over next 5 sts, 6 dc2tog over next 12 sts, repeat * across to last 3 sts, [ch 1, cl] 3 times over 3 sts, ch to close cl -78 sts
- Row 4: Ch 1, turn, starting in ch 1 to close cl, sc in each st and ch across - 120 sts
- Repeat Row 3-4 fourteen more times for short, twenty more times for long. Finish off and weave in ends.
- Blocking is recommended. You can find a wet blocking tutorial here.
- Add fringe as desired. You can find a Adding Fringe tutorial <u>here</u>.
