

# Snowman Wall Hanging



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## Materials



- o Yarn: See page 4
- o Hook: Furls Odyssey L 7.00mm, or hook to match gauge
- o Scissors
- o Yarn Needle
- o Measuring Tape
- o Tape
- o Stitch Marker
- o Optional: Plastic Canvas, Wooden Dowels long enough to cover the width of the wall hangings size, hair spray, embellishments (see end of large and small pattern for ideas), glue gun and glue sticks,
- o Safety Eyes (12mm for small hanging, 16mm for large hanging)

### Winter Snowman!

Create a 3D wall hanging that really catches everyone's eye! This hanging can be made with so many different colors, yarn weights, and embellishments, there isn't one that will look the same!



### Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: Using Biggo Yarn and L or Simply Wool Bulky/Wool of the Andes and N
  - 10 sc = 4"
  - 11 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Width
Large	18"	12"
Small	14"	8"

### Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single Crochet
- BLO: Back Loop Only
- Slst: Slip Stitch
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- \*: Repeat according to instructions

**Special Pattern Notes:**

This pattern is worked in the round continuously. Use a stitch marker to keep track of the first or last stitch. Working in the round reduces ends to weave in and allows for a nice backing. Plastic canvas can be inserted before closing so the wall hanging keeps its shape better when hung.

This pattern uses crochet, weaving, and fringe techniques. Find how to add fringe [here](#). Watch this [video tutorial](#) of how to weave.

This pattern has instructions for two sizes. Meet gauge using same or similar yarn to create an 8" width or 12" width wall hanging. If gauge is off or different yarn is used, sizes may vary.

The wall hanging is worked from the top down. Stitch counts include chains.

Embellishments may include, but are not limited to:

Bells, floral/greenery, mistletoe, pinecones, tassels, shells, stones, air succulents, wooden cutouts, etc

If you're not a fan of roving, faux fur can be found in most craft stores in the fabric section. When cutting fur fabric, keep scissors as close to the fabric as possible, trying not to cut the fur itself.

Yarn Used (all purchased from We Crochet)Color A: Background Color

(Large: Simply Wool Bulky Weight in Wilbur; Small: Wool of the Andes Bulky in Mineral Heather)

Color B: Background Fringe Color

(Large: Biggo Bulky in North Pole Heather; Small: Wonderfluff Bulky in Black Cherry Heather)

Color C: Snowman Color hold 2 or more strands together if not using roving

(All: Wool of the Andes Unspun Roving in Dove Heather)

Color D: Nose Color

(All: Mighty Stitch Worsted in Orange)

Color E: Scarf Color

(Large: Galileo in Gem; Small: Wonderfluff Bulky in Wonderland Heather)

### *Pattern Instructions*

#### **Larger Snowman Wall Hanging**

Ch 31 with Color A

Round 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 2 sc, sc in next 28 chs, 2 sc in last ch, rotate to work down opposite side of chain, sc in next 28 chs - 60 sts

Use BLO for following rounds.

Rounds 2-4: Sc in each st around - 60 sts

Round 5: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next, repeat \* three more times, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 6: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 7: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 8: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 9: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* four more times, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 10: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 11: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, sc in next sc, sc in next ch 1 space, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 12: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 13: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, sc in next sc, sc in next ch 1 space, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 14: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 15: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 16: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 17: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining st around - 60 sts

Round 18: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 19: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* four more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining st around - 60 sts

Round 20: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* four more times, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Round 21: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* four more times, sc in remaining st around - 60 sts

Round 22: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 60 sts

Next section will be worked in rows.

Row 1: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1 sc in next - 11 sts

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times - 9 sts

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next - 9 sts

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times - 8 sts

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next - 9 sts

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time - 6 sts

Finish off and weave in ends.

Add any surface crochet with Color F now.

### Background Fringe

Cut 15" strips of Color B. Only add fringe to the single crochets on Round 22, adding two strands behind the snowman body. Do not add fringe to any rows.

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## Weaving the Large Wall Hanging

Weaving will only be worked in the chain 1 spaces. Take roving Color C and separate in two length wise. Tape the ends and start weaving the head. Weave from right to left, keeping the working roving pulling upwards. Rotate piece as you work around head. Work the roving the same way for the body.

### Nose

Ch 5 with Color D and hook to match weight. Leaving a tail for sewing.

Row 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, hdc across - 4 sts

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 hdc2tog over next 4 sts - 2 sts

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, hdc2tog over next 2 sts - 1 st

Finish off and weave in end tail. Using beginning tail sew the 4 sts through the roving curving the beginning ch slightly. Secure.

### Scarf

All yarn weights can be used. Chain a length that measures roughly 1" with Color E. Stitch counts with vary

Row 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, hdc across

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, hdc in same and each st across

Repeat Row 2 until 12" in length. Add fringe to last row if desired.

Beginning row of scarf will need to be stuck in side of wall hanging. Optional: Hot glue to secure in place on wrong side. Take other end and loop it between any stitches of the background by the other side of the neck. Come back around with that end and loop through scarf that is secured.



## Finishing

Attach 16mm safety eyes to head of snowman.

Optional: Cut plastic canvas just under the measurements of your top portion of wall hanging (Rounds 1-21). Insert canvas and sew up bottom using Color A and working under snowman body so sewn area is not visible from front.

Weave in all ends. Single crochet wooden dowel on top of wall hanging (or attach a strand to each corner for hanging).

Add any embellishments.

## **Smaller Snowman Wall Hanging**

Ch 21 with Color A

Round 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 2 sc, sc in next 18 chs, 2 sc in last ch, rotate to work down opposite side of chain, sc in next 18 chs - 40 sts

Use BLO for Rounds.

Rounds 2-3: Sc in each st around - 40 sts

Round 4: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next, repeat \* three more times, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 5: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 6: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 7: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts



Round 8: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
repeat \* three more times, sc in remaining sts around - 40  
sts

Round 9: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in  
next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, sc in remaining sts  
around - 40 sts

Round 10: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
repeat \* one more time, sc in next sc, sc in next ch 1 space,  
sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 11: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, ch 1, skip 1, sc in  
next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next sc, repeat \* one  
more time, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 12: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 13: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in  
next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in  
remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 14: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc in remaining sts  
around - 40 sts

Round 15: Sc in next and next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in  
next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times, ch 1, skip 1, sc  
in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Round 16: Sc in next, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space,  
repeat \* four more times, sc in remaining sts around - 40 sts

Next section will be worked in rows.

Row 1: Sc in next sc, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc  
in next ch 1 space, repeat \* three more times - 10 sts

Row 2: Turn, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch  
1 space, repeat \* three more times - 9 sts

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1,  
skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* two more times - 8  
sts

Row 4: Turn, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time, ch 1, skip 1, sc in last sc - 7 sts

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc in next ch 1 space, \*ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, repeat \* one more time - 6 sts

Row 7: Turn, sc in next ch 1 space, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next ch 1 space, ch 1, skip 1, sc in last sc - 5 sts

Finish off and weave in ends.

Add any surface crochet with Color F now.

### Background Fringe

Cut 10" strips of Color B. Only add fringe to the single crochets on Round 22, adding two strands behind the snowman body. Do not add fringe to any rows.

### Finishing Large Wall Hanging

Weaving will only be worked in the chain 1 spaces. Take roving Color B and separate in two length wise. Tape the ends and start weaving the head.

### Nose

Ch 5 with Color D and hook to match weight. Leaving a tail for sewing.

Row 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, hdc across - 4 sts

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 hdc2tog over next 4 sts - 2 sts

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, hdc2tog over next 2 sts - 1 st

Finish off and weave in end tail. Using beginning tail sew the 4 sts through the roving curving the beginning ch slightly. Secure.

### Scarf

All yarn weights can be used. Chain a length that measures roughly 1" with Color E. Stitch counts with vary

Row 1: Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, hdc across

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, hdc in same and each st across

Repeat Row 2 until 12" in length. Add fringe to last row if desired.

Beginning will need to be stuck in side of wall hanging.

Optional: Hot glue to secure in place on wrong side. Take other end and loop it between any stitches of the background by the other side of the neck. Come back around with that end and loop through scarf that is secured.

### Finishing

Attach 12mm safety eyes to head of snowman.

Optional: Cut plastic canvas just under the measurements of your top portion of wall hanging (Rounds 1-21). Insert canvas and sew up bottom using Color A and working under snowman body so sewn area is not visible from front.

Weave in all ends. Single crochet wooden dowel on top of wall hanging (or attach a strand to each corner for hanging).

Add any embellishments.
