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Materials



- o Yarn: I Love This Yarn
- o Hook: Boye I/9-5.50MM
- o 2 buttons: Either both 1" or one being $1\frac{1}{2}$ "
- o Nylon Thread or heavy duty thread

A new way to weave! This scarf is a perfect match for the Dream Weaver Beanie and unique from any other scarves!

This pattern has a detachable flower that can be used to keep the scarf together, or wrap it your favorite way!



Sizing

- These measurements can be adjusted for desired length.
- Gauge: I hook 6 dc = 2" 3 rows = 2"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length
Young child	36″
Older child	48″
Short	55 ″
Medium	70″
Long	82″

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Slst: Slip stitch
- Sk: Skip
- Sp: Space
- St(es): Stitch(es)
- * *: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated

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Special Pattern Notes:

- Specialty Stitching: When working the Woven Shell Stitch, make sure you work in front of the first set of dcs when working in skipped stitches. The first set of dcs may be partially or completely hidden working over the stitches. If this happens, carefully pull on the ch 3 or top of the dcs to even out the stitches.
- Unique double crochet 3 together (Udc3tog): *YO, insert hook into next st, YO and pull up a loop* repeat 2 more times (7 loops on hook,) YO and pull through all loops on hook

Pattern Instructions

- Ch 22 (approx 5" width scarf)
- Ch 27 (approx 7" width scarf)
- Row 1: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook, *sk 3 chs, 3 dc in next ch, ch 3, 3 dc in 2nd sk ch, sk next ch after weave just made, dc in next* repeat across (3 weaves, 4 weaves)
- Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc,) turn, 2 dc in same, sc in next ch 3 sp, *sk 5, 3 dc in next st, ch 3, 3 dc in 2rd sk st, sc in next ch 3* repeat across, 3 dc in turning ch (2 weaves, 3 weaves)
- Row 3: Ch 1 (counts as sc,) turn, (count turning ch as first skipped stitch in first skipped st) *sk 5, 3 dc in next st, ch 3, 3 dc in 2nd sk st, sc in next ch 3 sp* repeat across, sc in turning ch (3 weaves, 4 weaves)
- Repeat rows 2 and 3 until piece measures according to chart on second page, making sure to finish on row 2. Continue to finishing notes.

Finishing Notes: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, hdc in next, *Udc3tog, hdc next st, sc next st, sc in ch 3 sp, sc in next, hdc in next* repeat across to turning ch, sc in turning ch (17, 23)

Add fringe if desired.

Detachable Flower:

(Use 2 strands for a larger flower)

With I hook Ch 4, join without twisting

Round 1: Work 10 hdc in ring just made, join (10 sts)

- Round 2: Ch 2, *sk 1, slst in next, ch 2* repeat around, slst in first ch 2 sp (5 ch 2 loops)
- Round 3: Ch 1, [hdc, 3 dc, hdc, slst] in first ch 2 sp, *slst in next, [hdc, 3 dc, hdc, slst] in next ch 2 sp* repeat around, do not join (5 petals)
- Round 4: Working behind the petals just made, *slst in next skipped st from round 2 (two rounds below,) ch 3* repeat around, slst in first ch 3 (5 ch 3 loops)
- Round 5: Ch 1, [5 dc, slst] in same ch 3 sp, *slst in next ch 3 sp, [5 dc, slst] in same ch 3 sp* repeat around, do not join (5 petals)

Finish off and weave in ends.

- Take one 1" button and place it over the hdc's from round 1. Take the second button (1-1½" button) and place it in the back directly behind the first one with the crocheted flower between. Sew the buttons securely with nylon thread but loose enough so the back button can be inserted between the stitches of 2 layers of the scarf.
- When using the button, make sure you push the button through one of the double crochets on a weave and not the center of a weave. This will insure a more secure fit.
