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Materials



- o Yarn: **Red Heart Soft in Teal**
5 oz, 141 g, 256 yards, 234 meters
- o Yarn: **Red Heart Shimmer in Snow**
3.5 oz, 100 g, 280 yards, 256 meters
- o Hook: Boye H/8-5.00MM hook
Boye I/9-5.50MM hook

Clusters of color!

This hat was designed for my lovely little niece! Uniquely textured, fun, and warm! Perfect for anyone in the family, boy or girl!



Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: H hook 7 sc = 2"
Sc using BLO 3 row = 2" height
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
0-6 months	6.5-7"	14"
6-12 months	7"	16"
1-3 years	7.5"	17"
3-6 Years	7.5"	19"
7-10 years	8"	19.75"
Teen/Adult	8-8.5"	20"

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single crochet
- Hdc: Half double crochet
- BLO: Back loop only
- Fpdc Cluster: Front post double crochet cluster
- Hdc3tog: Half double crochet three together
- YO: Yarn over
- * *: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated

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Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch. Join to first stitch of each round.

When working the Front Post Double Crochet Clusters 2 rounds below, you will leave the loops of next stitch unworked.

I worked two colors, using the second color only when working the front post double crochet clusters. For color changing tutorial, see pictures at end of pattern.

For a most custom fit or if stitch height is different than listed above, work brim rows in multiples of four.

Specialty Stitching: Front Post Double Crochet Cluster (fpdc cluster): *YO, insert hook into stitch indicated, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook* repeat twice more (4 loops on hook,) YO and pull through all loops on hook

Half double crochet 3 together (hdc3tog): YO, insert hook in stitch indicated, YO and pull up a loop, *YO, insert hook in next stitch, YO and pull up a loop* repeat once more (7 loops on hook,) YO and pull through all loops on hook

Pattern Instructions

Brim (with H hook):

Ch 7

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across (6 sts)

Row 2:

0-6 months: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 48 rows.

6-12 months: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 56 rows.

1-3 years: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 60 rows.

3-6 years: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 64 rows.

6-10 years: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 68 rows including row 1.

Teen/Adult: Turn, ch 1, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)
Repeat until you have 72 rows including row 1.

Match both ends together. Ch 1, slst in each st *and* beginning chain like picture below. This joins the two ends. Turn the band just made so that the slsts are on the inside of the piece. This is now considered the wrong side.



You will now turn your work so you will be working on the ends of the rows just worked like picture below.



Note: Following stitch counts will be the same as amount of rows you made in your brim unless otherwise noted.

Hat: (Switch to I Hook or one hook larger)

Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in same and each row end around, join

Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join

Round 3: After the first round of fpdc clusters, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst. See first picture at end of pattern.

Slst in next st, ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until piece measure according to chart below, ending on round 2. The number of clusters per round will remain the same throughout until working decreases in the following instructions.

Size	Length	# of clusters
0-6 months	5.5-6"	12
6-12 months	6"	14
1-3 years	6.5"	15
3-6 years	6.5"	16
6-10 years	7"	17
Teen/adult	7.5"	18

Round 4: Slst in next st, ch 1, *hdc3tog, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* join. (24 sts, 28 sts, 30 sts, 32 sts, 34 sts, 36 sts)

Note: Stitch counts above goes in chronological order as well as any further stitch counts.

Round 5: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join. If working clusters in second color, change to that color when joining.

Note: Stitch counts are same as previous round

Round 6: Slst in next 2, ch 1, *fpdc cluster around hdc3tog from 2 rounds below, sk 1* repeat around, join (12 sts, 14 sts, 15 sts, 16 sts, 17 sts, 18 sts)

Finishing Notes:

Finish off leaving a long tail for sewing. Using a yarn needle, weave long tail through stitches and pull to close. Secure tightly and weave in all ends.

Optional: Add a pom pom on top.

Photo Tutorial Section



After the first round of fpdc clusters, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst.

Color Changing Tutorial



When working the color change, work the stitch as normal but when pulling through the last time, YO with new color and finish.
