o Yarn: Red Heart Soft in Teal

5 oz, 141 g, 256 yards, 234 meters

Red Heart Shimmer in Snow

3.5 oz, 100 g, 280 yards, 256 meters

o Hook: Boye H/8-5.00MM hook Boye I/9-5.50MM hook

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: H hook 7 sc = 2" Sc using BLO 3 row = 2" height
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

together

• Hdc3tog: Half double crochet 3

together

Slst: Slip stitch

• YO: Yarn over

- Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch. Join to first stitch of each round. Stitch counts will remain the same as the previous round unless noted. When multiple counts are listed, they will be listed in chronological order.
- When working the Front Post Double Crochet Clusters, you will leave the loops unworked. Picture tutorial at end of pattern on Front Post Double Crochet Cluster placement.
- I worked two colors, using the second color only when working the front post double crochet clusters. See color changing tutorial at end of pattern.
- When working in the chain for the thumb hole, hdc over the second color so it doesn't interfere with wearing the glove.
- Specialty Stitching: Front Post Double Crochet Cluster (fpdc cluster): *YO, insert hook into stitch indicated, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook* repeat twice more (4 loops on hook,) YO and pull through all loops on hook

Pattern Instructions

Cuff

Toddler (1-3 years): With H hook ch 7

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (6 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 16 rows including row 1.

Small Child (3-6 years): With H hook ch 7

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (6 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 20 rows including row 1.

Large Child (6-10 years): With H hook ch 9

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (8 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (6 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 20 rows including row 1.

Teen/Small Adult: With H hook Ch 11

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (10 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (10 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 24 rows including row 1.

Medium Adult: With H hook Ch 11

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (10 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (10 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 28 rows including row 1.

Large Adult: With H hook Ch 11

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc across (11 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in BLO of each st across (11 sts)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 32 rows including row 1.

Match both ends together. Ch 1, slst in each st and beginning chain like picture below. This joins the two ends. Turn the band just made so that the slsts are on the inside of the piece. This is now considered the wrong side.





You will now turn your work so you will be working on the ends of the rows just worked like picture below.



Continue to corresponding size.

- Toddler: (Switch to I Hook or one hook larger)
- Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in same and each row end around, join (16 sts)
- Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join
- Round 4: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 5: When working the fpdc clusters in this round and throughout, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst.
 - Slst in next st, ch 5 with last ch being second color if working 2 colors, sk joining st and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join to first ch (18 sts/chs)
- Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in each ch and st around, join (18 sts)
- Round 7: Slst in next st, ch 1, 2 hdc2tog over the next 4 sts, hdc in next, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join (16 sts)
- Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, join
- Round 9: Slst in next st, ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join
- Round 10: Repeat Round 8
- Round 11: Repeat Round 9
- Round 12: Repeat Round 8
- Round 13: Slst in next st, ch 1, starting in same st *hdc, hdc2tog, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below* repeat around, join (12 sts)

- Round 14: Ch 1, starting in same st *hdc2tog, hdc in next* repeat around, join (8 sts)
- Round 15: Ch 1, sc2tog around, join (4 sts)
- Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

 Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.

Thumb:

- Round 1: Attach yarn with a single crochet to the right most st, sc 9 around thumb hole evenly, join (10 sts)
- Round 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (10 sts)
- Round 4: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc 3* repeat once more, join (8 sts)
- Round 5-7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (8 sts)
- Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

 Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.
- Make a second mitten to complete the pair!
- Small and Large Child Mitten: (Switch to I Hook or one hook larger)
- Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in same and each row end around, join (20 sts)
- Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join
- Round 4: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 5: When working the fpdc clusters in this round and throughout, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst.

Slst in next st, ch 5 with last ch being second color if working 2 colors, sk joining st and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join to first ch (22 sts/chs)

Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in each ch and st around, join (22 sts)

Round 7: Slst in next st, ch 1, 2 hdc2tog over the next 4 sts, hdc in next, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join (20 sts)

Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, join

Round 9: Slst in next st, ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join

Round 10: Repeat Round 8

Round 11: Repeat Round 9

Round 12: Repeat Round 8

For Large Child only, repeat round 9 and 8 once more.

Round 13: Slst in next st, ch 1, starting in same st *hdc, hdc2tog, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below* repeat around, join (15 sts)

Round 14: Ch 1, starting in same st *hdc2tog, hdc in next* repeat around, join (10 sts)

Round 15: Ch 1, sc2tog around, join (5 sts)

Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.

Thumb:

Round 1: Attach yarn with a single crochet to the right most st, sc 9 around thumb hole evenly, join (10 sts)

Round 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (10 sts)

- Round 4: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc 3* repeat once more, join (8 sts)
- Round 5-7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (8 sts)
- For Large Child Only: Repeat round 7 twice more.
- Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

 Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.
- Make a second mitten to complete the pair!
- Small, Medium and Large Adult Mitten: (Switch to I Hook or one hook larger)
- Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in same and each row end around, join (24, 28, 32 sts)
- Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join
- Round 4: Ch 1, hdc in same and each st around, join
- Round 5: When working the fpdc clusters in this round and throughout, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst.
 - Slst in next st, ch 7 with last ch being second color if working 2 colors, sk joining st and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join to first ch (28, 32, 36 sts/chs)
- Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in each ch and st around, join
- Round 7: Slst in next st, ch 1, hdc2tog, hdc3tog, hdc2tog, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join (24, 28, 32 sts)
- Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, join

- Round 9: Slst in next st, ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below, *hdc in next 3, fpdc cluster in st 2 rounds below* repeat around, join
- Round 10: Repeat Round 8
- Round 11: Repeat Round 9
- Round 12: Repeat Round 8
- Round 13: Repeat Round 9
- Round 14: Repeat Round 8
- Round 15: Repeat Round 9
- Round 16: Repeat Round 8
- Round 17: Repeat Round 9
- Round 18: Repeat Round 8
- For Medium and Large Adult only, repeat round 9 and 8 once more.
- Round 19: Slst in next st, ch 1, starting in same st *hdc, hdc2tog, fpdc cluster in st 2 round below* repeat around, join (18, 21, 24 sts)
- Round 20: Ch 1, starting in same st *hdc2tog, hdc in next* repeat around, join (12, 14, 16 sts)
- Round 21: Ch 1, sc2tog around, join (6, 7, 8 sts)
- Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

 Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.

Thumb:

- Round 1: Attach yarn with a single crochet to the right most st, sc 12 around thumb hole evenly, join (13 sts)
- Round 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (13 sts)
- Round 4: Ch 1, *sc2tog, sc 3* repeat once more, sc in last 2 sts, join (10 sts)

Round 5-9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join (10 sts)

For Medium and Large Adult only, repeat round 5 once more.

Round 10: Ch 1, sc2tog around, join (5 sts)

Finish off leaving a long tail. Thread yarn needle with tail.

Weave tail through front loops of remaining stitches. Pull to close and secure.

Make a second mitten to complete the pair!

After the first round of fpdc clusters, you will be working the hdc after the fpdc cluster from 2 rounds below. The last fpdc cluster will be worked 2 rounds below the beginning slst.

Color Changing Tutorial





When working the color change, work the stitch as normal but when pulling through the last time, YO with new color and finish.
