

Angelina Slouch



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Materials



- o Yarn: Red Heart Boutique Swanky
3.5 oz, 100 g, 202 yards, 185 meters
- o Hook: Boye I/9-5.50MM

The summer months are coming! I always feel a touch of sadness packing away my winter hats. But the Angelina Slouch hat is perfect for those cooler spring days and nights!

Suitable for any child or adult that wants to add a little extra glamour to their attire, this hat is light and airy, and Red Heart Boutique Swanky makes it eye-catching and unforgettable!



INTERMEDIATE

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Boutique Swanky is stretchy, other yarns may vary with results.
- Gauge: I hook 10 hhdc = 4"
3 rows = 1"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
3-10 years	8"	18"
Teen/Adult	9"	20"

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Sk: Skip
- Sp(s): Space(s)
- Hhdc: Herringbone half double crochet
- Cl: Cluster
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- * *: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated
- []: Repeat instructions all in

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Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch unless noted. Join to first stitch of each round unless noted.

Work a double crochet cluster as [dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc].

Work a single crochet cluster **as** [sc, ch 3, sc].

Make all chains within the pattern loosely.

Round 5 of both sizes, and round 6 of teen/adult, have a measurement in red at the end. This is the approximate diameter of those rounds.

When counts are listed in the edging, they will be listed with 3-10 year first, then teen/adult.

Specialty Stitching: Herringbone Half Double Crochet (hhdc): YO, insert hook into indicated st, YO and pull through stitch/space *and next loop on hook*, YO and pull through last 2 loops on hook

Pattern Instructions

3-10 Years

With I hook, magic circle:

Round 1: Ch 2, *dc cl, ch 1, sc cl, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first dc (2 dc cl, 2 sc cl)

Round 2: Slst in next ch sp, ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, join to first sc (4 sc cl, 2 dc cl)

Round 3: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first dc (4 dc cl, 4 sc cl)

Round 4: Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp between dcs, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp between dcs, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first sc (8 sc cl, 4 dc cl)

Round 5: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat twice more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat three more times, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first dc(8 dc cl, 8 sc cl) 5.5-6"

Body of Slouch

Round 6: For this round, you will want to work your ch 3's loosely. You will not want the chs to pull your work in. Slst to next ch 1 sp, *slst to middle dc of cl, ch 3* repeat three more times, *slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 3* repeat 3 times, repeat instructions from first * once more, join to first ch 3 sp (16 ch 3 sps)

Round 7: Ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, *sc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat around, join to first sc (8 dc cl and 8 sc cl, here and throughout)

Round 8: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, *sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat around, join to first dc

Round 9: Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, *sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat around, join to first sc

Repeat round 8 and 9 until piece measures 7" ending with either round. Do not finish off. Continue to Edging of Slouch.

Edging of Slouch (Continue working below based on which round you ended with.)

If ending on round 8 (dc cl will be first):

Round 1: Ch 1, hhdc in same st, hhdc in next 2 dcs, hhdc in next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next ch 3 sp, hhdc in next ch 1 sp, *hhdc in next 3 dcs, hhdc in next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next ch 3 sp, hhdc in next ch 1 sp* repeat around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Round 2-3: Ch 1, hhdc in each st around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

If ending on round 9 (sc cl will be first):

Round 1: Slst in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, hhdc in same sp, hhdc in next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next 3 dc (skipping the ch 1 sps,) hhdc in next ch 1 sp, *hhdc in next ch 3 sp, hhdc in next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next 3 dc, hhdc in next ch 1 sp* repeat around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Round 2-3: Ch 1, hhdc in each st around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Finish off and weave in ends.

Teen/Adult

With I hook, magic circle:

Round 1: Ch 2, *dc cl, ch 1, sc cl, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first dc (2 dc cl, 2 sc cl)

Round 2: Slst in next ch sp, ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, join to first sc (4 sc cl, 2 dc cl)

Round 3: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first dc (4 dc cl, 4 sc cl)

Round 4: Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join to first sc (8 sc cl, 4 dc cl)

Round 5: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat twice more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat three more times, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat once more, join (8 dc cl, 8 sc cl) 5.5-6"

Round 6: Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp* repeat twice more, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat three more times, *sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc cl in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp* repeat three more times, *dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat three more times, join (16 sc cl, 8 dc cl) 6.5-7"

Body of Slouch

Round 7: For this round, you will want to work your ch 3's loosely. You will not want the chs to pull your work in. *Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 3* repeat seven more times, *slst to middle dc, ch 3* repeat three times, repeat instructions once more, join to first ch 3 sp (24 ch 3 sps)

Round 8: Ch 1, sc cl in same sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, *sc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1*

repeat around, join to first sc (12 cl each, here and throughout)

Round 9: Slst to next ch 3 sp, ch 2, dc cl in same sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, *sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1* repeat around, join to first dc

Round 10: Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, *sk next ch 1 sp, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk next ch 1 sp, dc cl in next ch 3 sp, ch 1* repeat around, join to first sc

Repeat round 9 and 10 until piece measures 8" ending with either round. Do not finish off. Continue to Edging of Slouch.

Edging of Slouch (Continue working below based on which round you ended with.)

If ending on round 9 (dc cl will be first):

Round 1: Ch 1, hhdc in same st, hhdc in next 2 dcs, sk next st next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next ch 3 sp, sk next ch 1 sp, *hhdc in next 3 dcs, sk next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next ch 3 sp, sk next ch 1 sp* repeat around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Round 2-3: Ch 1, hhdc in each st around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

If ending on round 10 (sc cl will be first):

Round 1: Slst in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, hhdc in same sp, sk next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next 3 dc, sk next ch 1 sp, *hhdc in next ch 3 sp, sk next ch 1 sp, hhdc in next 3 dc, sk next ch 1 sp* repeat around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Round 2-3: Ch 1, hhdc in each st around, join to first hhdc (48 sts)

Finish off and weave in ends.
