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Materials



- Yarn: Worsted Yarn in 3 colors (such as Red Heart With Love, Red Heart Soft, I Love This Yarn, Vanna's Choice, etc)
- Hook: H/8-5.00mm
I/9-5.50mm
- Scissors
- Measuring Tape

Love the Cold!

What better way to enjoy the cold weather than with a stylish cowl or scarf! This is a great pattern to use up the scrap yarn when doing the contrast color rounds.

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: H hook 12 hdc = 4"
11 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Scarf	Length
Young Child	36"
Older Child	48"
Short	55"
Medium	70"
Long	82"

Cowl	Circumference
Tight Single Wrap	26"
Loose Single Wrap	32"
Double Wrap	60"

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single crochet
- Sc3tog: Single Crochet 3 Together
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- * *: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated
- []: Repeat instructions all in one stitch

Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch unless noted. Join to first stitch of each round unless noted.

When stitch counts are listed, they will be listed in sequential order.


Length can be adjusted as desired, lengths listed are just recommendations.

When working in any half double crochets, work between all 3 horizontal bars.

Carry yarn up edges.

More than 3 colors can be used. If using more than 3 colors, you will not end on Color C after repeating the sc3tog rows/rounds.

Stitch Legend	
○	ch - chain
T	hdc - half double crochet
+	sc - single crochet
↗	sc3tog - single crochet 3 together
O	t-ch1 - single turning chain



Scarf Pattern Instructions

Thin Width: Ch 18 (5.5" width)

Thick Width: Ch 26 (8" width)

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, hdc across - 17, 25 sts

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, hdc in same and each st across - 17, 25 sts

Repeat Row 2 until length measures 2".

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc3tog starting in same, *ch 1, sc3tog starting in last leg of previous st, repeat * across, sc in same - 8, 12 sc3tog

Repeat Row 3 for 3". Total length should be 5".

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, hdc in each st and ch across - 17, 25 sts

Repeat Row 4 until length measures 5" less than desired length in chart below. Finish off and weave in ends.

Size	Length
Young child	36"
Older child	48"
Short	55"
Medium	70"
Long	82"

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc3tog starting in same, *ch 1, sc3tog starting in last leg of previous st, repeat * across, sc in same - 8, 12 sc3tog

Repeat Row 5 for 3" for just these rows. Amount of Rows should match amount of Row 3 repeated.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, hdc in same and each st across - 17, 25 sts

Repeat Row 6 until length measures total length on chart.

Finish off and weave in ends. If desired, sc around edge of scarf, working 3 sc in each corner.

Cowl Pattern Instructions

Thin Width: Ch 28 (9" cowl length)

Thick Width: Ch 36 (12" cowl length)

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, hdc across - 27, 35 sts

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, hdc in same and each st across - 27, 35 sts

Repeat Row 2 until length measures 12".

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sc3tog starting in same, *ch 1, sc3tog starting in last leg of previous st, repeat * across, sc in same - 13, 17 sc3tog

Repeat Row 3 for 10". Total length should be 22".

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, hdc in each st and ch across - 27, 35 sts

Repeat Row 3 until length desired on chart below.

Size	Length
Tight Single Wrap	26"
Loose Single Wrap	32"
Double Wrap	60"

Do not finish off. To join ends, match up Row 1 and last row worked. If you prefer one side over the other, make sure the right sides are together. Ch 1. Slst through both rows across to join them. Do not finish off. Turn right side out. Switch to an I hook. Turn so you are working the raw edges of the cowl. Sc in each row end around. Join to first sc. Finish off and weave in ends. Join yarn by seam on raw edge on other side. Ch 1 and sc in each row end around. Join to first sc. Finish off and weave in ends.
