

Charismatic Beanie



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Materials



- Yarn: Loops and Threads Charisma; 2 skeins: 1 main color, 1 contrast color (colors pictured are Electric Blue and Charcoal)
- Hook: L-8.00mm
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors

Warmth!

INTERMEDIATE

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 9 sc = 4"
9 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
1-3 year	7-7.5"	16"
3-10 year	7.5-8"	18"
Small	8-8.5"	20"
Teen/adult		
Large	8-8.5"	22"
Teen/Adult		

**** This pattern has a negative ease but using Charisma yarn, stretches very well.**

Pattern Key

- Ch(s): Chain(s)
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Slst(s): Slip Stitch(es)
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- *: Repeat instructions between symbol until indicated
- []: Repeat instructions all in one stitch

Special Pattern Notes:

Main color is listed as Color A in pattern, contrast color is listed as Color B. When not using a color, keep strand on wrong side of work.

Chains are not are counted in the stitch totals at the end of each round.

Beanie is meant to be fitted. For a more loose beanie, make one size larger. Working a larger size will also decrease gaps in top of hat. If using yarn that doesn't have as much stretch as Charisma, work a size larger. It's recommended to test amount of stretch after working the first 3 rounds.

Pattern Instructions

1-3 Year Ch 35 with Color B, join without twisting

3-10 Year Ch 40 with Color B, join without twisting

Small Teen/Adult Ch 45 with Color B, join without twisting

Large Teen/Adult Ch 50 with Color B, join without twisting

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in same and each ch around, join - 35, 40, 45, 50 sts

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same and each st around, join - 35, 40, 45, 50 sts

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same and each st around, join switching to Color A - 35, 40, 45, 50 sts

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same, ch 2, 3 dc in next, skip 3, *sc in next, ch 2, 3 dc in next, skip 3, repeat * around, join in 1st sc, slst in next 2 chs - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Round 5: With Color B slst in next dc, ch 1, sc in same dc and next 2 dc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, *sc in next 3 dc,

sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, repeat * around, join to 1st sc switching to Color A - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Round 6: (WS) Turn, slst in next ch 3 space, ch 1, [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, *[sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, repeat * around, join to 1st sc with Color B - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Round 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc (behind ch 1) and next 3 dc, ch 3, skip ch 2, *sc in next sc, sc in next 3 dc, ch 3, skip ch 2, repeat * around, join to 1st sc - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Round 8: Slst in next 3 sc, slst in next ch 3 space switching to Color A, ch 1, [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, *[sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, repeat * around, join to 1st sc - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Round 9: Slst in next 2 chs, slst in next dc switching to Color B, ch 1, sc in same dc and next 2 dc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, *sc in next 3 dc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, repeat * around, join to 1st sc switching to Color A - 28, 32, 36, 40 sts

Repeat Rounds 6-9 until length measures {7-7.5, 7.5-8, 8-8.5, 8-8.5}". If ending on Round 6, turn work before continuing.

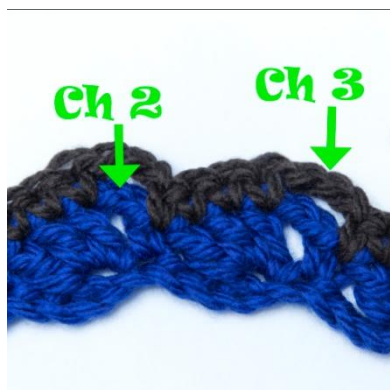
Slst to next ch space (either ch 2 on Rounds 6 or 8, or ch 3 on Rounds 7 or 9). Ch 1, sc in each ch space around, join.

Finish off leaving a long tail. Weave through remaining stitches and pull tight to close. Secure and weave in ends.

Edging

Join Color A to back of hat (where join from beginning chain is). Slst very loosely (or increase hook size) in each beginning chain around. Join. Finish off and weave in ends.

The chain 2 is in the main color, the chain 3 is in the contrast color.



Work [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below. You'll be working over the ch 3.
