Materials



o Yarn: Loops and Threads Charisma; 3 skeins: 2 main color, 1 contrast color (colors pictured are Electric Blue and Charcoal)

- o Hook: L-8.00mm
- o Measuring Tape
- o Scissors

Warmth!

Don't like the cold? This cowl will definitely keep you nice and toasty! The stitch combo paired with Loops and Threads Charisma makes for a luxuriously warm cowl. Love it? Find the matching beanie here.



Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 9 sc = 4" 9 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
One Size	9"	28"

Pattern Key

- Ch(s): Chain(s)
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Slst(s): Slip Stitch(es)
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- RS: Right Side
- WS: Wrong Side
- *: Repeat instructions between symbol until indicated
- []: Repeat instructions all in one stitch

Special Pattern Notes:

- Chains are not are counted in the stitch totals at the end of each round.
- Main color is listed as Color A in pattern, contrast color is listed as Color B. When not using a color, keep strand on wrong side of work. By crocheting over the strands when working the next round, they can be hidden if intention is the wear the cowl folded. (Folded cowl pictured on page 2.)


Pattern Instructions

With Color A, ch 70, join without twisting

- Round 1: (RS) Ch 1, sc in same, ch 2, 3 dc in next, skip 3, *sc in next, ch 2, 3 dc in next, skip 3, repeat * around, join in 1st sc, slst in next 2 chs 56 sts
- Round 2: (RS) With Color B slst in next dc, ch 1, sc in same dc and next 2 dc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, *sc in next 3 dc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip ch 2, repeat * around, join to 1st sc switching to Color A 56 sc
- Round 3: (WS) Turn, slst in next ch 3 space, ch 1, [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, *[sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, repeat * around, join to 1st sc with Color B 56 sts
- Round 4: (RS) Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc (behind ch 1) and next 3 dc, ch 3, skip ch 2, *sc in next sc, sc in next 3 dc, ch 3, skip ch 2, repeat * around, join to 1st sc 56 sc
- Round 5: Slst in next 3 sc, slst in next ch 3 space switching to Color A, ch 1, [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, *[sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below working over ch 3, skip 4 sc, repeat * around, join to 1st sc 56 sts

Repeat 3-6 twice. Repeat Rounds 3-5. Finish off and weave in ends.

The chain 2 is in the main color, the chain 3 is in the contrast color.



Work [sc, ch 2, 3 dc] in ch 2 space 2 rounds below. You'll be working around the ch 3.
