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## Materials



- o Yarn: Red Heart Soft in Off White and Navy  
5 oz, 141 g, 256 yards, 234 meters
- o Hook: Boye H/8-5.00mm

### Lovely Texture!

This is a lovely, elegant slouch hat uses the clover fan stitch.

The unique texture makes this slouch one of a kind and perfect for everyday use or worn with a more elegant attire.

Multiple color combinations are perfect for this hat!

### Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 14 hdc = 4"  
9 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
Adult	9"	18"

\*Circumference will stretch to fit a 22" head

### Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single crochet
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Sc dec: Single crochet decrease
- Slst: Slip stitch
- Sk: Skip
- Sp: Space
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- \* \*: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated
- [ ]: Repeat instructions all in one stitch
- { }: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated

**Special Pattern Notes:** Beginning chain does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch unless noted. Join to first stitch of each round unless noted.

**Specialty Stitching:**

**Partial CVC:** [YO, insert hook into indicated st, draw up a loop loosely] twice (5 loops on hook), YO and draw through 4 loops, YO and draw through 2 loops on hook

**CVC:** [YO, insert hook into indicated st, draw up a loop loosely] twice (5 loops on hook), [YO, insert hook into next st, draw up a loop loosely] twice, (9 loops on hook), YO and draw through 8 loops, YO and draw through 2 loops on hook

**Pattern Instructions**

Magic Circle

Round 1: Work 10 hdc in circle, join (10 sts)

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, join (20 sts)

Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in same, 2 hdc in next, \*hdc next, 2 hdc in next\* repeat around, join (30 sts)

Round 4: Ch 1, hdc in same and next, 2 hdc in next, \*hdc next 2, 2 hdc in next\* repeat around, join (40 sts)

Round 5: Ch 1, hdc in same and next 2, 2 hdc in next, \*hdc next 3, 2 hdc in next\* repeat around, join (50 sts)

Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in same and next 3, 2 hdc in next, \*hdc next 4, 2 hdc in next\* repeat around, join (60 sts)

Round 7: Ch 1, 2 hdc in same, hdc next 4, 2 hdc in next, \*hdc next 5, 2 hdc in next\* repeat around to last 6 sts, hdc next 4, 2 hdc in next 2, join (72 sts)

Round 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sk 2, 5 dc in next, sk 2, \*sc next, sk 2, 5 dc in next, sk 2\* repeat around, join (12 dc groups)

Round 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in same, \*sk 2, sc, ch 1, sk 3, partial CVC in next, [ch 2, CVC in same st] repeat 3 times, ch 2, partial CVC in same, ch 1, sk 3, sc next, sk 2, 5 dc in next\* repeat around ending with only 2 dc in same st as ch 3 and first 2 dc, join to ch 3 (4 CVC groups)

Round 10: NOTE: you will be skipping over the ch 2s from previous round

Ch 1, turn, sc in same, sk 3 sts and ch 1, partial CVC in next st, [ch 2, CVC in same st] repeat 4 times, ch 2, partial CVC in same, sk ch 1 and next 3 sts, \*sc next, sk 3 sts and ch 1, partial CVC in next st, [ch 2, CVC in same st] repeat 4 times, ch 2, partial CVC in same, sk ch 1 and next 3 sts, sc next\* repeat around, join (4 CVC groups)

Round 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st and each st around as well as 2 sc in each ch 2 sp, join (80 sts)

Round 12: Slst in next 9 sts, ch 1, turn, working over slst just made sc in same st, sk 3, 5 dc in next, {sk 2, sc next, sk 2, 5 dc in next}, repeat {} once more, sk 3, \*sc next, sk 3, 5 dc in next, {sk 2, sc next, sk 2, 5 dc in next}, repeat {} once more, sk 3\* repeat around, join (12 dc groups)

Round 13: Repeat Round 9

Round 14: Repeat Round 10

Round 15: Repeat Round 11

Round 16: Repeat Round 12

Round 17: Repeat Round 9

Round 18: Repeat Round 10

Round 19: Repeat Round 11

Round 20: Ch 1, sc in same and next 2, sc dec, \*sc next 3, sc dec\* repeat around, join (64 sts)

Round 21: Ch 1, sc in same and next 5, sc dec, \*sc next 6, sc dec\* repeat around, join (56 sts)

Continue to desired edging.

### **Standard Edging**

Round 22-24: Ch 1, sc in same and each st around, join (56 sts)

Finish off and weave in ends.

### **Scalloped Edging**

Round 22: Ch 1, sc in same, sk 1, 5 dc in next, sk 1, \*sc next, sk 1, 5 dc in next, sk 1\* repeat around, join.

Finish off and weave in ends.
