

Deer Appliqué



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Materials



- o Yarn: I love This Cotton color Taupe
Small amount of black, and darker brown (red if working a red nose)
- o Hook: Boye F/5-3.75MM
Boye E/4-3.50MM

Oh, Deer!

This deer appliqué can be used for many things! Add it to a hat, a blanket, gloves, clothing!

Perfect for the holiday season or for that hunter in your life!

This quick and simple pattern will add character to anything!



Sizing

- Gauge: F hook 9 sc = 2"
4 rows = 1"
- Size of appliqué can be changed with hook and yarn sizes.

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- St(s): Stitch(es)
- Sc: Single crochet
- Hdc: Half double crochet
- Dc: Double crochet
- Slst: Slip stitch
- Sk: Skip

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Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch unless noted. Join to first stitch of each round unless noted.

Exclude the antlers if you would prefer a doe.

Pattern Instructions

Deer Head with F hook (using Taupe):

For section 1: Ch 6 in Taupe

Row 1: Starting in 2ndch, from hook, sc 5 (5 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc across (5 sts)

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sk 1, sc 4 (4 sts)

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc 4 (4 sts)

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sk 1, sc 3 (3 sts)

Do not FO, this part will remain attached and be connected with slip stitches from section 2

For section 2 (see pictures at end of pattern for help):

Ch 4

Row 1: Starting in 2ndch from hook sc 3, turn, slst in same st as first ch from section 1 coming from the back side (4 sts)

Row 2: (Do not ch 1) turn, sc in the next st, sc next 2 (3 sts)

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st and next 2, slst in closest st from section 1 (4 sts)

Row 4: (Do not ch 1) turn, sc in the next st, sc 2 (3 sts)

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st and next 2, slst in closest st from section 1 (4 sts)

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 2, slst (4 sts)

Row 7: Turn, sc in next st and next 2 (3 sts)

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next st, slst (3 sts)

Row 9: Turn, sc in next st, slst (2 sts)

Finish off.

Edging with F hook (using Taupe):

Attach yarn to tail of starting yarn. Ch 1, sc evenly up the back of the neck (roughly 8-10 sts), sc in same st

On the top of the head, sc to the nose (roughly 7-9 sts), sc in same

Sc on tip of nose (roughly 1-2 sts)

Slst down jaw line and crook of neck (roughly 3-4 sts),

Sc down front of neck (roughly 3-5 sts), sc in same

Bottom of appliqué: sc 2, hdc, dc, [dc, hdc] in next st, ch 1, slst to first sc

Finish off.

Ear with E hook and using Taupe:

Leave a long starting tail for sewing, Ch 5

Starting in 2nd ch from hook, hdc, sc 2, 3 sc in last ch

Working down opposite side of ch, sc 2, hdc in last ch (same ch as starting sc) slst to first hdc (9 sts)

Finish off.

Antler with E hook and using darker brown:

Ch 12

In 2ndch from hook slst, slst in next 3, ch 4, in 2ndchslst 3, slst in next ch on main ch, slst in next, ch 3, in 2ndch slst 2, slst in next on main ch, slst in next 4. Finish off and weave in all ends.

Finishing Notes: Sew together the pieces as in the picture above. Use the black to weave through the stitches to
