o Yarn: 1 skeineach Caron Simply Soft Colors:Grey, White, Soft Pink

6 oz, 170 g, 315 yds, 288 m

Boye I/9-5.50MM depending on size

o Other: Any embellishments

o Hook: Boye H/8-5.00MM or

Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: H hook 7 hdc = 2"

 I hook 6 hdc = 2"

 2 rows = 1"

Pattern Key

• Ch: Chain

• Dc: Double crochet

• Sk: Skip

• St(s): Stitch(es)

• Sp: Space

• * *: repeat instructions between symbols until indicated

• []: repeat what is between in stitch indicated

- Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Work first stitch into joining stitch unless noted. Join each round to the first stitch.
- If your width from back to front doesn't match the chart above, repeat rows 2 and 3 until you reach that length making sure to end with row 3.
- To make the bonnet hug the face when worn, switch to a hook 1 or 2 sizes smaller on the last 2 rows. If you notice the last few rows starting to flare out, this is recommended.

Pattern Instructions

Premie/Newborn start with H hook

0-3 Months start with I hook

With H hook, magic circle

Round 1: Ch 1, 9 hdc in circle, join (9sts)

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, join (18sts)

- Round 3: Ch 1, *hdc next, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (27sts)
- Round 4: Ch 1, *hdc next 2, 2hdc in next* repeat around, join (36sts)

You will now be working back and forth in rows.

- Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1,)sc in same, *sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next st, sk 2, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next st* repeat 3 more times, sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next, sk 2, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in next (5 dc shells, 4 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)
- Row 2: Turn, ch 3 (counts as dc,) 2 dc in same, *[sc, ch 3, sc] in ch 2 sp, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp* repeat 3 more times, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp, 3 dc in ch 3 sp from previous round (5 sc shells, 4 dc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 3: Turn, ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1 sp,) sc in same, *[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp* repeat 3 more times, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in ch 3 from previous round (5 dc shells, 4 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 4: Repeat row 2

Row 5: Repeat row 3

Row 6: Repeat row 2

Row 7: Repeat row 3

Do not finish off and continue to finishing notes.

3-6 Months start with H hook

With H hook, magic circle

Round 1: Ch 1, 9 hdc in circle, join (9sts)

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, join (18sts)

Round 3: Ch 1, *hdc next, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (27sts)

Round 4: Ch 1, *hdc next 2, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (36sts)

Round 5: Ch 1, *hdc next 3, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (45sts)

You will now be working back and forth in rows.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1,)sc in same, *sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next st, sk 2, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next st* repeat 4 more times, sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next, sk 2, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in next (6 dc shells, 5 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 2: Turn, ch 3 (counts as dc,) 2 dc in same, *[sc, ch 3, sc] in ch 2 sp, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp* repeat 4 more times, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp, 3 dc in ch 3 sp from

previous round (6 sc shells, 5 dc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 3: Turn, ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1 sp,) sc in same, *[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp* repeat 4 more times, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in ch 3 from previous round (6 dc shells, 5 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 4: Repeat row 2

Row 5: Repeat row 3

Row 6: Repeat row 2

Row 7: Repeat row 3

Row 8: Repeat row 2

Row 9: Repeat row 3

Do not finish off and continue to finishing notes.

6-12 Months start with H hook

1-3 years start with I hook

Magic circle

Round 1: Ch 1, 9 hdc in circle, join (9sts)

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, join (18sts)

Round 3: Ch 1, *hdc next, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (27sts)

Round 4: Ch 1, *hdc next 2, 2hdc in next* repeat around, join (36 sts)

Round 5: Ch 1, *hdc next 3, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (45sts)

Round 6: Ch 1, *hdc next 4, 2 hdc in next* repeat around, join (54sts)

You will now be working back and forth in rows.

- Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1,) sc in same, *sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next st, sk 2, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next st* repeat 6 more times, sk 2, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next, sk 2, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in next (8 dc shells, 7 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)
- Row 2: Turn, ch 3 (counts as dc,) 2 dc in ch 1 sp, *[sc, ch 3, sc] in ch 2 sp, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp* repeat 6 more times, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp, 3 dc in ch 3 sp from previous round (8 sc shells, 7 dc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)
- Row 3: Turn, ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1 sp,) sc in same, *[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 3, sc] in next ch 2 sp* repeat 6 more times, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 3 sp, [sc, ch 1, hdc] in ch 3 from previous round (8 dc shells, 7 sc shells, 1 partial shell on each end)

Row 4: Repeat row 2

Row 5: Repeat row 3

Row 6: Repeat row 2

Row 7: Repeat row 3

Row 8: Repeat row 2

Row 9: Repeat row 3

Row 10: Repeat row 2

Row 11: Repeat row 3

Do not finish off and continue to finish notes.

Finishing Notes: Turn bonnet so you are working on the neckline. Using a hook one size smaller than you worked the bonnet, work 2 sc in each row end, work 1 sc in each of the hdc of the last round, and work 2 sc in each row end to the other end. Finish off and weave in ends. You can also use a hook two sizes smaller if you would like it more tight around the neckline.

Optional: Weave ribbon through shells or add any embellishments.
