

Starlight Slouchy



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Materials



- o Yarn: Bulky or Worsted weight yarn
- o Hook: Boye H/8-5.00MM hook for *worsted* version
Boye K/10½-6.50MM hook for *bulky* version
Boye G/6-4.25MM hook for star appliqué

Warmth from the stars!

This is a great hat to work up in either bulky or worsted yarn. Add the star appliqué, or any other one, for a more personal touch!



Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: H hook 7 hdc = 2"
H hook 2 rows = 1"
K hook 5 hdc = 2"
K hook 3 rows = 2"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Circumference
3-10 Years	8"	20"
Teen/Adult	10"	22"

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single crochet
- Hdc: Half double crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Fpdc: Front post double crochet
- Fphdc: Front post half double crochet
- Slst: Slip stitch
- Sk: Skip
- St(es): Stitch(es)
- Sp: Space
- * *: Repeat instructions between symbols until indicated
- []: Repeat instructions all in one stitch

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Special Pattern Notes: Beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the first stitch into joining stitch. Join to first stitch of each round.

Work a chainless foundation for a cleaner beginning, join.

Length of slouch can be increased or decreased depending on preference. Repeat round 6 on both versions more or less to reach desired length.

Stitch count will remain the same unless noted. If stitch count is listed, child will be listed first, teen/adult after.

Body of hat can be made without turning for another great look!

Double crochet 3 together (dc3tog): YO, insert hook into stitch indicated, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through 2 loops, *YO, insert hook into next st, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through 2 loops on hook* repeat once more, YO and pull through all 4 loops on hook

Star appliqué can be adjusted in size by using a larger or smaller hook and/or different weights of yarn.

See picture tutorial at end of pattern to see how I closed the opening at the end. It can be done in other ways though.

Main picture is made using bulky directions with Sensations Sincerely yarn even though it's a 4 weight.

Pattern Instructions

Bulky Weight Directions: with K hook

3-10 years: Chain 48, join without twisting

Teen/Adult: Chain 52, join without twisting

Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in each ch around, join

Round 2: Ch 1, fpdc in same, dc in next, *fpdc in next, dc in next* repeat around, join

Round 3: Repeat round 2

Round 4: Ch 1, fphdc in same, fphdc in next, *fphdc in next, hdc in next* repeat around, join

Round 5: Ch 1, [sc, dc] in same, sk 1, *[sc, dc] in next st, sk next* repeat around, join

Round 6: Ch 1, turn, [sc, dc] in same st, sk 1, *[sc, dc] in next st, sk next* repeat around, join

Repeat round 6 until your piece measure length below:

Size	Length
Child	8"
Teen/Adult	10"

Round 7: Ch 1, turn, sk same and next st, slst in next, *sk next st, [sc, dc] in next st, sk next, slst in next st* repeat around, join to ch 1 (36 sts, 39 sts)

Round 8: Ch 1, turn, sk same and next st, [sc, dc] in next st, sk 2 sts, slst in next st, *sk 2 sts, [sc, dc] in next st, sk 2 sts, slst in next st* repeat around, join to first sc (22 sts, 18 sts)

Leave a long tail and finish off. Continue to finishing notes.

Worsted Weight Directions: with H hook

3-10 years: Chain 56, join without twisting

Teen/Adult: Chain 64, join without twisting

Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in each ch around, join

Round 2: Ch 1, fpdc in same, dc in next, *fpdc in next, dc in next* repeat around, join

Round 3: Repeat round 2

Round 4: Ch 1, fphdc in same, fphdc in next, *fphdc in next, hdc in next* repeat around, join

Round 5: Ch 1, [sc, dc] in same, sk 1, *[sc, dc] in next st, sk next* repeat around, join

Round 6: Ch 1, turn, [sc, dc] in same st, sk 1, *[sc, dc] in next st, sk next* repeat around, join

Repeat round 6 until your piece measure length below:

Size	Length
Child	8"
Teen/Adult	10"

Round 7: Ch 1, turn, sk same and next st, slst in next, *sk next st, [sc, dc] in next st, sk next, slst in next st* repeat around, join to ch 1 (44 sts, 48 sts)

Round 8: Ch 1, turn, sk same and next st, [sc, dc] in next st, sk 2 sts, slst in next st, *sk 2 sts, [sc, dc] in next st, sk 2 sts, slst in next st* repeat around, join to first sc (22 sts, 24 sts)

Leave a long tail and finish off. Continue to finishing notes.

Finishing Notes: Weave tail through stitches opposite each other and pull tight. See pictures in photo tutorial section.

Star Appliqué: Use G hook

Magic loop

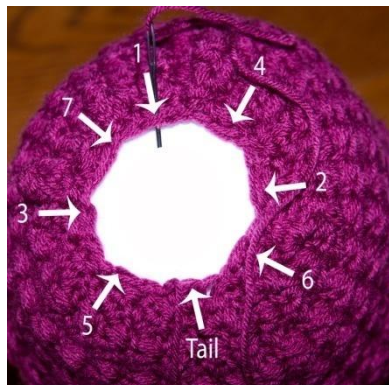
Round 1: Ch 1, *2 hdc, ch 1* repeat 5 times total, join

Round 2: *Slst to next ch 1 sp, ch 2, dc3tog in same ch 1 sp, ch 2, slst between the next 2 hdc's from previous round* repeat around

Finishing off leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew star into desired place. Sewing the points of the star down will give more of a star look. If you don't sew the points down, they will curl up and have more of a flower appearance. Weave in all ends.

Photo Tutorial Section

Please note pictures are for demonstrating closing the top of the hat only. They may not have the correct amount of stitches as they are for reference only.



Sew tail according to numbers above. Weave yarn over then under and pull tight.



Pull tight as you weave through.



Finished looked.
