

Sunglasses/Glasses Case



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Materials



- o Yarn: Worsted Weight Yarn in 3 Colors
Yardage has been rounded. Color A: 65 yds; Color B: 8 yds;
Color C: 10 yds
- o Hook: H 5.00mm
- o Scissors
- o Yarn Needle
- o Measuring Tape

Protect those glasses!

Whether its sunglasses or glasses, protect them with this quick project! This is perfect for stash busting, craft fairs and gifts!



Sizing

- These measurements are approximated, and actual subjects may vary.
- Gauge: 15 sc = 4"
16 rows = 4"
- This pattern comes in the following sizes:

Size	Length	Width
One Size	4"	8.5"

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single Crochet
- RS: Right Side
- WS: Wrong Side
- Slst(s): Slip Stitch(es)
- St(s): Stitch(es)

Special Pattern Notes:

It's easier to work with Color B and C if yardage is precut.

When working with multiple colors, work over yarn with the exception of the beginning and end of each Row using Color A. (Increase yardage if working over Color B and C throughout the entire piece. Estimated yardage does not include this.)

Keep tension on non-working colors when working over them.

Working in front of strands, not over strands, may result in glasses getting caught on strands inside case.

When switching colors, work in new color yarn on last pull through of previous stitch. Each Row will start and end with Color A. Color A is main color of case. Color B is frame color. Color C is lens color.

Pattern InstructionsCase Back

Ch 31 with Color A

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch, sc in each ch across - 30 sts

Rows 2-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across - 30 sts

Do not finish off.

Edging:

Round 1: Ch 1, turn, 3 sc in same, sc in next 28 sts, 3 sc in last sc, turn piece to work down raw edge, work 13 sc evenly down raw edge, turn piece to work down beginning ch, 3 sc in first ch, work a sc in each of the next 28 chs, 3 sc in last ch, turn piece to work down other raw edge, work 13 sc evenly down raw edge, join - 94 sts

Finish off and weave in ends.

Case Front

Ch 31 with Color A

Row 1: (RS) Starting in 2nd ch, sc in each ch across - 30 sts

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across - 30 sts

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 5, with Color B sc 5, with Color A sc 8, with Color B sc 5, with color A sc next 6 - 30 sts

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc same and next 4, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 5, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 6, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 5, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 5 - 30 sts

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc same and next 4, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 6, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 4, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 6, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 5 - 30 sts

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 3, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 8, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 8, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 4 - 30 sts

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 3 - 30 sts

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 3 - 30 sts

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next, with Color B sc 2, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 4, with Color C sc 9, with Color B sc 2, with Color A sc 2 - 30 sts

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 3, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 8, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 2, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 8, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 4 - 30 sts

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 4, with Color B sc 1, with Color C sc 6, with Color B sc 6, with Color C sc 6, with Color B sc 1, with Color A sc 5 - 30 sts

Color C yarn can now be trimmed/cut.

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and next 5, with Color B sc 6, with Color A sc 6, with Color B sc 6, with Color A sc 6 - 30 sts

Color B yarn can now be trimmed/cut.

Rows 13-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in same and each st across - 30 sts

Edging:

Round 1: Ch 1, turn, 3 sc in same, sc in next 28 sts, 3 sc in last sc, turn piece to work down raw edge, work 13 sc evenly down raw edge, turn piece to work down beginning ch, 3 sc in first ch, work a sc in each of the next 28 chs, 3 sc in last ch, turn piece to work down other raw edge, work 13 sc evenly down raw edge, join - 94 sts

Do not finish off. Continue to Joining below.

Joining

With wrong sides together, match front and back piece. The front piece may be slightly larger due to working over yarns and tension change working with multiple yarns.

Row 1: Slst in next st on front piece and adjacent piece joining the two pieces together, slst both pieces together over the next 78 sts - 79 slsts

Finish off. This will leave 15 stitches on each side for the opening. Weave in ends.
